Layout [lay-out]

An action generally associated with jazz dancing. When performing the step, begin by developing working leg and letting hips push through creating a hinge line. The supporting leg should bend as the foot begins to relevé (forced arch), but maintain a turn out or parallel, depending on the choreography. Arms should float behind shoulders as if dancer was "laying" down. A layout can also be performed with the head maintaining the body line.

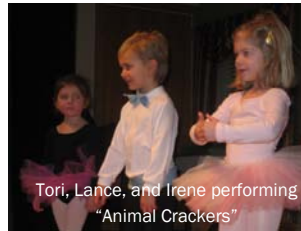

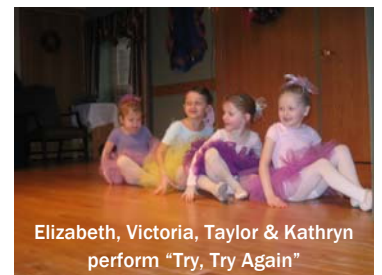
