Tanaquil LeClercq

DID YOU KNOW--


Cricket's "fairy logo" was created by local artist Melissa Goodling inspired by a photo the famous ballerina Tanaquil LeClercq in the ballet Metamorphosis.

At the age of twelve she was offered a scholarship to the school of American Ballet. At the age of fifteen, when Tanaquil was fifteen Balanchine asked her to dance with him in a choreography he made to be performed at a benefit for a Polio charity.

She was George Balanchine's fifth wife. She became the queen of the American Ballet Theater until her career was cut short by polio at the age of 27 and was paralyzed from the waist down. She occasionally taught from her wheelchair at the Dance Theater of Harlem, demonstrating with her hands, and coached the young dancers at the New York City Ballet that were now doing the parts she once had done herself. She died of pneumonia in Manhattan on December 31, 2000 at the age of 71.
